1. You must be a 2019 graduating high school student.
2. You must have participated in the WHS Choir Department for at least two (2) years.
3. The scholarship must be used for the purpose of study at an accredited college, university, or music school.
4. Applications must be returned to the choir office by 4:30 PM on April 26th. LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
5. Recipients will be named and honored at the Choir Banquet.

A committee appointed by the *Wylie Choir Booster Board* will determine selections. Their decision will be based on the following criteria:

- 40% - Essays
- 15% - Community/Work/Other School Activities
- 15%-GPA
- 30% - WHS Choir Activities/Involvement

*A Director's Evaluation Rubric, reflecting the every-day participation, work-ethic, and character of the individual will also be blindly attached for the committee. If any scholarship recipient does not accept the scholarship, the scholarship will be awarded to the next applicant on the ranked list.
