

Wylie High School Pirate Choirs Supplementary Music Program 2019-2020 Financial Assistance Information Sponsored by the Wylie High Choir Boosters

Wylie High Choir department is pleased to be able to offer high quality, degreed professionals to teach private voice lessons at highly discounted rates; however, we do understand that even these rates, lesson might be beyond the budget of some of our families. In effort to make music enrichment lessons accessible to as many students as possible, we have established a program through which students may apply for financial assistance.

Requirements of Scholarship Applicants:

1. Students must be enrolled in a WHS Pirate Choir
2. Students must submit a Supplementary Music Program Enrollment Application
3. Students must submit a Supplementary Music Program Financial Assistance Application online at www.wyliechoir.com
4. Student and parent must be willing to assist the booster club by volunteering for at least 2 concession stand dates of the WHS volleyball or basketball home games for the 2019-2020 season

Award Amounts

The WHS Choir has a finite budget for financial assistance. In effort to provide the needed assistance to as many students as possible, scholarship amounts will vary. As part of the application process, students and parents are asked to indicate the per lesson amount that will fit into their family budgets. Except in cases of extreme need, requests for financial assistance covering more than half of the lesson costs will not be granted. A small commitment and investment by student and parents is essential to the success of this program, therefore, requests for full scholarships will not be considered.

Requirements of Scholarship Students

Students that receive financial assistance from the WHS Pirate Choir Booster Club are required to:

1. Abide by the guidelines of the Choral Department as outlined in the WHS Pirate Choir Handbook.
2. Participate in the following musical enrichment events sponsored by the WHS Pirate Choir:
 - a. TMEA All-State Choir Auditions
 - b. Solo & Ensemble Contest
 - c. Vocal Studio Recitals & other assigned performances
3. Participate in all Choral Department fundraising events
4. Remain academically eligible throughout the course of their enrollment in the Supplementary Music Program

Submission of Application

Applications for financial assistance should be submitted online at www.wyliechoir.com. Scholarships will be processed as the completed information is received. Prompt return of this material will greatly contribute to the timely processing of your application. Applications will be reviewed in the order they are received, and award letters sent out as quickly as possible so that students requesting assistance can begin their studies. Students who submit applications after all available funds have been disbursed will be added to a waiting list in case additional funds become available. **Deadline for submission is August 23rd.**

Notification and Terms of Awards Scholarship Award

Notification will be sent out prior to the student's first lesson. Scholarships will terminate at the conclusion of each school year. A scholarship can be terminated at any time by the director of the WHS Pirate Choirs for failure to meet the above requirements, failure to attend lessons on a regular basis, or other reasons defined by the director.
